



# Michigan At-A-Glance for Consultants

**IQIP is CDC's national, provider-level immunization quality improvement (QI) program.**

**The purpose of IQIP** is to promote and support the implementation of provider-level immunization quality improvement strategies designed to increase vaccine uptake among children and adolescents in adherence to the routine schedule recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

**IQIP provides technical assistance** to providers to support **four core QI strategies plus one optional custom QI strategy** to advance immunization priorities. Michigan does not currently have a custom QI strategy.

## Michigan IQIP strategies\*

- Facilitate return for vaccination
- Leverage IIS functionality to improve immunization practice
- Give a strong vaccine recommendation (emphasize HPV vaccine if provider has adolescent patients)
- Strengthen vaccination communications
- **Optional, awardee-developed strategy**

\*Providers must select at least 2 strategies to implement or improve (if already implemented)

## Michigan 12-month IQIP Process

### IQIP Site visit

- Observe provider workflow
- Review initial coverage
- Select QI strategies
- Provide technical assistance
- Choose action items for strategy implementation plan

### 2-month and 6-month check-ins

- Review progress toward strategy implementation
- Provide technical assistance
- Update strategy implementation plan

### 12-month follow-up

- Review progress toward strategy implementation
- Provide technical assistance
- Review year-over-year coverage change
