

Vaccines for Children (VFC) Patient Eligibility Screening Record

VFC eligibility screening and documentation must take place with each immunization visit and recorded in MCIR.
Providers may utilize the below form to document screening.

3. To determine if a child (0 through 18) is eligible to receive federal vaccine through the VFC and state programs, providers must screen child at each immunization visit. Providers must enter the date, indicate the appropriate eligibility and document in MCIR. Please visit www.michigan.gov/vfc for more information about different public programs such as MI-AVP, Universal Hepatitis B, or High-Risk Hepatitis A & B Vaccine.

To be eligible for VFC vaccine, patients must be under 19 years old and meet one of the criteria listed below in columns A-D.

**Underinsured includes children who have health insurance but it does not cover vaccines or only covers specific vaccine types. Children are only eligible for VFC vaccines if insurance does not cover the vaccine.*
