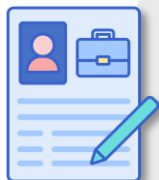

USING THE MICHIGAN FOSTER CARE PORTAL TO:



Fill out, submit and track your foster care license application all in one place.



The Michigan Foster Care Portal is **available for use 24/7** so you can access it anytime, from any phone, tablet or computer connected to the web.



You can **browse** and **contact** agencies that interest you.



You can connect with a **Foster Care Navigator** through the portal to help you begin the application process.

The Michigan Foster Care Portal (MFCP) is a one stop shop to begin the licensing process. This will support an increase in the timeliness of licensure. As prospective foster parents complete steps in the MFCP, the portal tracks your progress and guides you to the next steps in the licensing process.

The portal will have contact information for agencies, as well as FAQs to assist you through the process.

When creating your account, please add your email and phone number. This will be helpful for contacted agencies and if you need to reset your password.
