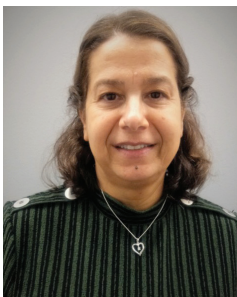

Thank you for choosing the **Wayne Health Department of Neurology** as your epilepsy care center. We will support you as a patient coming from the pediatric clinic by guiding you throughout the transition process.

Our clinical services are housed at the **Detroit Medical Center's Adult Central Campus**. We are a **Level 4 Epilepsy Center** as recognized by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers, the highest level that can provide exceptional care!

Clinic Services

Our comprehensive epilepsy program provides state of the art medical and surgical treatment:

- Epilepsy Monitoring Unit, ambulatory home EEGs, outpatient routine EEGs
- Advanced medical treatment including new clinical trials
- Surgical treatment including Vagus Nerve Stimulator (VNS), Responsive Neurostimulation® System (RNS) and Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS)
- Consultation for Modified Atkins and Ketogenic diets for treatment of epilepsy
- Specialized epilepsy care to young women, including counseling on contraception and pregnancy

Privacy and Communication

An important aspect of transitioning from pediatric to adult care is that we keep your medical information **confidential**.



Because you are now an adult, we cannot discuss your medical information with anyone without your written permission or consent.

If you would like your parent(s) or guardian(s) to be kept in the loop, you must add them via a signed HIPAA form. HIPAA forms can be filled out during your appointment or by contacting our epilepsy nurse, JeanneMarie Trotta at 313-745-1416.

It is your choice whether to give permission and you can always change your mind about this.



Frequently Asked Questions

How do I get medication refills?



- Keep close watch on how many refills you have left. Call our epilepsy nurse, JeanneMarie Trotta at 313-745-1416 as soon as you reach “zero” refills.
- Allow **2 weeks** for refills to coordinate between nurses, doctors, pharmacists and insurance companies when needed.

How do I make or change an appointment?

- Call our general number or epilepsy nurse to make, reschedule, or cancel an appointment.
- If calling outside office hours, leave a message with **your full name and date of birth**.
- Most appointments will be with your regular doctor. For urgent appointments you may be seen by one of our nurse practitioners who can communicate with your doctor.
- We will call to remind you about your appointments; contact us immediately if you need to reschedule.

How do I get forms and paperwork filled?

- Forms can be brought during your visit, or call our epilepsy nurse to arrange to have them completed. Allow up to 2 weeks for physician letters, regulatory agency forms, and school seizure plans.
- Be sure to give us your best phone number so we can reach you with any questions or when the forms are ready.
