June 6, 2024, 12 noon to 1 pm

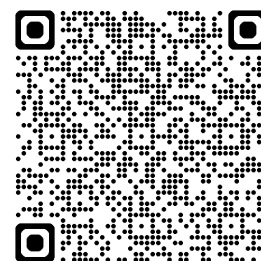
