REPORTING CHANGES



How do you know what to report?

You will get a letter from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) telling you what reporting rules you must follow for your FAP benefits.

If you have been told you are a “**simplified reporting**” group this means you are only required to report certain changes.

Changes You are Required to Report to MDHHS as FAP **Simplified Reporters**:

Reporting Rules for Simplified Reporters

Most FAP groups only need to report the following changes:

- ✓ You or another FAP group member receives a lottery and/or gambling winning of \$4,500 or more.
- ✓ Your FAP group’s total actual (not net) income goes over the simplified reporting income limit for your group size.
 - Tip: You will find this income limit on the Decision Notice you were sent when your FAP benefits were approved.

You do not need to report any additional changes! MDHHS will send you a notice every 6 months to check your FAP eligibility.

*These reporting rules are only for FAP. You may still need to report changes for other programs.

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
