Subject: Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) Program

Effective: As Indicated

Programs Affected: Medicaid, Healthy Michigan Plan

Effective state fiscal year 2024, all regular and special DSH pools, except for the Institute for Mental Disease (IMD) DSH pool, will be discontinued within the DSH program. The significant expansion of the Hospital Rate Adjustment (HRA) supplemental payment program limits hospital capacity for DSH payments. Discontinuing all but the IMD DSH pool will improve the ability of the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to effectively distribute allotted DSH funds given the limited future capacity of qualified hospitals. Additionally, this policy ends the DSH Eligibility Status Verification form requirement for discontinued DSH pools. Eligibility and distributions associated with the IMD DSH Pool will continue in alignment with existing methodology.

Manual Maintenance
