Subject: Flint Water Group Eligibility Criteria Update

Effective: October 1, 2025

Programs Affected: Medicaid (Flint Water Group)

The United States Environmental Protection Agency lifted the emergency order on drinking water in the City of Flint on May 19, 2025. As a result of the change, an individual will need to have been served by the Flint water system between April 1, 2014, and September 30, 2025, to be eligible for the Flint Water Group.

An individual was served by the Flint water system if he or she consumed water drawn from the Flint water system and:

- resided in a dwelling connected to the Flint water system,
- had employment by an entity served by the Flint water system, or
- received childcare or education in a dwelling/structure connected to the Flint water system.

Eligibility is also available to children born to pregnant women served by the Flint water system during the specified time-period, as long as the other eligibility requirements above are met.
