This Letter is to notify MI Health Link Integrated Care Organizations and other interested stakeholders that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) intends to submit Waiver application amendment requests for the MI Health Link program to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

The anticipated effective date for the MI Health Link waiver amendment is January 1, 2026.
