Hospital Graduate Medical Education (GME) Funds

To receive funds for GME, a hospital must have operated a nationally accredited medical education program(s) in the fiscal year that data is drawn from the hospital cost reports used to calculate the GME payments. Adjustments made to the amount of the GME Funds Pool and Primary Care Pool due to legislative action or executive order are posted on the MDHHS website. Additional detail regarding GME funds is available in Section 8 of the Hospital Reimbursement Appendix in the Medicaid Provider Manual.
