This bulletin transmits information necessary for billing for blood lead poisoning follow -up services for dates of service on and after August 1, 2001.

Home Health Agency

If a home health agency c onducts a nursing assessment/investigation visit for blood lead poisoning, the following new procedure code must be used on the Home Health Invoice (MSA -1651 form).

NEW CODE	DEFINITION	OLD CODE
Z6220	nursing assessment/investigation visit for blood lead poisoning	70116

Local Health Departments

Local health departments enrolled to perform blood lead poisoning follow -up services must follow all of the completion instructions presented in the revised Chapter IV, distributed by bulletin MSA 01 -01.

To bill I for environmental investigations, the following new procedure codes must be used.

NEW CODE	DEFINITION	OLD CODE
Z6200	environmental blood lead poisoning investigation	300025
Z6210	follow-up environmental blood lead poisoning investigation	300026

To bill for the nursing assessment/investigation visits, the following new procedure code must be used.

NEW CODE	DEFINITION	OLD CODE
Z6220	nursing assessment/investigation visit for blood lead poisoning	300027


