



Service Systems Utilizing MichiCANS: *An Informational Guide*

The MichiCANS is an information integration tool designed to explore and communicate the needs and strengths of the child/youth and family. **The MichiCANS consists of two parts:**

MichiCANS Screener – used widely across Michigan to assist with determining level of need.

MichiCANS Comprehensive – integrates all components of the MichiCANS screener and is completed at intake and periodically to determine eligibility for the Michigan Intensive Child and Adolescent Services (MICAS) and reflect growth and progress throughout services provided by a Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan (PIHP), Community Mental Health Service Provider (CMHSP) or Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC) and their contracted providers.

This chart helps professionals, youth and families understand where to get more information about how the MichiCANS is being used across the state by different service systems.
