Bulletin <u>MSA 20-76</u>, issued December 8, 2020, addressed the application of the 85% occupancy limitation to Tier II COVID Relief (CR) Facilities. (Refer to the <u>Michigan Department</u> <u>of Health and Human Services [MDHHS] Medicaid Provider Manual</u>, Nursing Facility Chapter, Cost Reporting and Reimbursement Appendix, Section 2, Definitions, Per Resident Day Cost.)

The purpose of this bulletin is to rescind the application of the 85% occupancy limitation for Tier II CR Facilities that was authorized in bulletin MSA 20-76. Effective March 1, 2023, CR Facilities with beds holding a Tier II designation are no longer exempt from the 85% occupancy limitation. The 85% occupancy limitation for Care and Recovery Centers (CRCs) will remain in place until further notice.
