State Plan Amendment Request to Update Medicaid Reimbursement Rates for Vaccine Administration Services

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to increase provider reimbursement rates for vaccine administration services. The anticipated effective date for this SPA is October 1, 2022.

The purpose of the SPA is to update the Medicaid State Plan information that establishes provider reimbursement rates for vaccine administration services in compliance with Section 1786 of Public Act 166 of 2022. MDHHS expects this change will have a positive impact on beneficiaries by improving immunization rates among those that are Medicaid-eligible.

The estimated gross cost to the State of Michigan for the SPA is \$14,061,000 per year.
