General Description and Examples of Work

General Description

The Health Educator can assist in providing (OR provide certain aspects of) nutrition services to WIC clients. The Health Educator may not perform all CPA functions, as they do not meet the qualifications to be a CPA.

Examples of Work

1. Provide direct nutrition education to clients [See MI WIC Policy Manual Chapter 5, Nutrition Services] **only in these settings:**
 - a. Classroom setting
 - b. Facilitating client completion of interim nutrition education in the clinic, i.e., self-directed education modules, bulletin boards, and wichealth.org.
2. Document Nutrition Education (NE) follow-up
3. Complete documentation of wichealth.org completion in MI-WIC
4. Participate in the Nutrition Education Workgroup, WIC Conference, webcasts, and trainings, to improve nutrition and program services, as appropriate.
