



MCSP NEWSBLAST: NAACCR Format for Submission of Data

August 12, 2022

Submission of all reportable cancer incidence case reports from hospitals, independent laboratories, physician offices, dentists and clinic directors **is required by Michigan Compiled Laws and [Administrative Rules on Cancer Reporting](#)**. All reportable conditions must be reported **within 180 days from the date of initial diagnosis**. All reportable pre-invasive cervical (C53) lesions should be **submitted within 90 days from the date of initial diagnosis**

Detroit Area Facilities (Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb)

The Metropolitan Detroit Cancer Surveillance System (MDCSS) is authorized by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) for the collection and reporting of individually identifiable cancer information. This grant of authority to MDCSS includes collecting all information necessary to identify and track patients and their diagnoses, treatment, subsequent primaries, and survival status. This authority also includes collection of data necessary to perform quality assurance on individual facilities' cancer reports. MDCSS collects all cancer case information for the Detroit area and submits consolidation case reports to MCSP.

If your facility is located in the Detroit area (Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb counties) **all reportable conditions must be submitted to MDCSS within 180 days from the date of initial diagnosis**. Please note! **MDCSS is able to accept submission of data in v22**. Non-Detroit Area Facilities

All hospitals, independent laboratories, physicians, dentist, and clinics who are not located in the Detroit area (Wayne, Oakland, Malcomb), who electronically submit cancer case reports to MCSP via the MI Web Plus application using proprietary cancer registry software (i.e., Elekta, METRIQ, OncoLog, Cstar) are to **submit all reportable conditions thru diagnosis year 2021 to MCSP via Web Plus in NAACCR v21**. SUBMISSION OF DATA DUE DATES

Diagnosis Year 2021 or earlier missed cancer case reports

- All reportable conditions for **diagnosis year 2021 or earlier missed case reports** must be submitted to MCSP or MDCSS (Detroit area facilities) **by Wednesday, August 31, 2022**.
- Note 1: No EXCEPTIONS or EXTENSIONS for late reporting of cancer case reports for diagnosis year 2021 or earlier will be granted by MCSP.
- Note 2: Non-compliance of Michigan Compiled Laws and Administrative Rules on Cancer Reporting, which mandates the reporting of all reportable conditions within 180 days of the date of initial diagnosis will be addressed by MCSP through collaboration with the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA).

Abstract Submission Schedule for Diagnosed Cases – 2022 and forward

- Submission schedule for diagnosis cases for diagnosis year 2022 and forward is as follows:

Month of Diagnosis...	Submit Abstract No Later Than...
January	July
February	August
March	September
April	October
May	November
June	December
July	January
August	February
September	March
October	April
November	May
December	June

Examples:

- All reportable conditions for February 2022 must be reported to MCSP or MDCSS (Detroit area facilities) **no later than August 31, 2022**.
- All reportable conditions for June of 2022 must be reported to MCSP or MDCSS (Detroit area facilities) **no later than December 31, 2022**.
- All reportable conditions for December 2022 must be reported to MCSP or MDCSS (Detroit area facilities) **no later than March 31, 2023**.
