

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

#### **Employment Relations Commission**

AUTHORITY: P. A. 380 OF 1965 As Amended

#### PURPOSE OF ELECTION

An election by secret ballot will be conducted under the direction and supervision of the Michigan Employment Relations Commission among the eligible voters described herein to determine the representative, if any, desired by them for the purposes of collective bargaining with their employer.

## **SECRET BALLOT**

The election will be by secret ballot. An agent of the Commission will mail a ballot to each eligible voter. The voter will mark the ballot and mail the ballot back to MERC in accordance with the mail ballot instructions.

#### **ELIGIBLE VOTERS**

EMPLOYERS: Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Home Help Caregiver Council (25-F-1170-RC)

#### Those persons eligible to vote are:

All individual home help caregivers selected by a participant or the participant's representative, who provides individual home help services to a participant. **Excluding**: Caregivers who provide services through an agency provider, an integrated care organization, or similar entity.

who were paid through the home help program to provide services between January 01, 2025 through July 01, 2025, including employees in the eligible classification who did not work during said period because they were ill, or on vacation or sick leave, or temporarily laid off, and employees in the military service of the United States but excluding any employees who have, since the payroll period eligibility date, quit or been discharged for cause and have not been rehired or re-instated prior to the date of the election, or who, because of other changes of work status, are no longer a part of the bargaining unit.

- Ballot Count starts Weds., Oct. 8, 2025 at 9:30am at the Cadillac Place--State of Michigan, 3026 West Grand Blvd., Detroit MI 48202 and continue each business day from 9:30am-5pm until complete, unless adjusted.
