Going Fishing this Summer? Remember... eat safe fish!

Fishing is fun! But, before you eat your catch, check to see if your fish is safe to eat. Go to www.michigan.gov/eatsafefish, or call the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) at 1-800-648-6942.

Do Not Eat

Do not eat fish caught in the Lange or Revere Canals in St. Clair Shores. Why? Because these fish have unsafe levels of chemicals called PCBs.

The chemicals can stay in your body for a long time, and may affect your health later.

Look for Signs!

Signs like this are posted around the Lange and Revere Canals. Use the signs as a reminder to not eat the fish caught in these waters.
