This bulletin is to notify you of the HCPCS (Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System) changes that will be implemented by the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) for dates of service on or after January 1, 2006.

Listed below are the HCPCS procedure code changes being adopted by MDCH for School Based Services.

Refer to your 2006 CPT and/or HCPCS codebooks and the CMS website <a href="www.cms.hhs.gov">www.cms.hhs.gov</a> for full descriptions of the new codes.

The modifiers will be applied to the new codes in the same manner as they were for the codes that they are replacing.

96116	Neurobehavioral status exam (clinical assessment of thinking, reasoning and judgment, e.g., acquired knowledge, attention, language, memory, planning and problem solving, and visual spatial abilities), per hour of the psychologist's or physician's time, both face-to-face time with the patient, and time interpreting test results and preparing the report	96115
96118	Neuropsychological testing (e.g., Halstead-Reitan Neuropsychological Battery, Wechsler Memory Scales and Wisconsin Card Sorting Test), per hour of the psychologist's or physician's time, both face-to-face time with the patient, and time interpreting test results and preparing the report	96117
97760	Orthotic(s) Management and training (including assessment and fitting when not otherwise reported), upper extremity(s) and/or trunk, each 15 minutes	97504
97761	Prosthetic training, upper and/or lower extremity(s), each 15 minutes	97520
