The purpose of this bulletin is to inform providers of additional medications now available under the *Plan First!* drug formulary.

Antifungal medications and Flagyl have been added to the *Plan First!* drug formulary. Coverage of these drugs is effective retroactive to July 1, 2006. The table below reflects the drugs/drug categories now available for *Plan First!* enrollees. The table is available as Table 6 of the Family Planning Waiver Codes--*Plan First!* document maintained on the MDCH website at www.michigan.gov/mdch >>Providers>>Information for Medicaid Providers>>Provider Specific Information.

Systemic Contraceptives	Trimethoprim
Tetracyclines	Antivirals *
Penicillins	Narcotic Analgesics **
Erythromycins	Non-Narcotic Analgesics **
Flagyl (NEW)	Streptomycins
Antifungal Medications (NEW)	
* This includes only general antiviral and topical antiviral medication for initial treatment of STI's. It does not include medications to treat HIV or Hepatitis B or C ** For sterilization surgical procedures.
