Subject: Six Month Extension in Reporting National Drug Codes by Outpatient Hospital Providers

Effective: January 1, 2008

Programs Affected: Medicaid

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide information related to the reporting of the National Drug Codes (NDCs) for physician administered drugs as described in Section 6.12 in the Billing & Reimbursement for Institutional Providers of the Michigan Medicaid Manual.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has granted a six month extension to allow outpatient hospital providers sufficient time to change their billing systems to accommodate the reporting of the NDCs for physician administered drugs to Michigan Medicaid. This extension is granted until June 30, 2008.

Effective July 1, 2008 outpatient hospital claims submitted without the NDCs as described in Section 6.12 in the Billing & Reimbursement for Institutional Providers of the Michigan Medicaid Manual will be rejected.
