
This letter serves as a reminder of the Phase II authorization and provision of NEMT by
MI Choice waiver agencies to MI Choice waiver participants that reside in the following
Michigan Counties:

Alcona, Alger, Allegan, Alpena, Arenac, Baraga, Barry, Barrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass,
Cheboygan, Chippewa, Crawford, Delta, Dickinson, Gogebic, Houghton, Ionia, Iosco, Iron,
Kalamazoo, Kent, Keweenaw, Lake, Livingston, Luce, Mackinac, Macomb, Marquette, Mason,
Mecosta, Menominee, Monroe, Montcalm, Montmorency, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oakland,
Oceana, Ogemaw, Ontonagan, Osceola, Oscoda, Otsego, Ottawa, Presque Isle, Roscommon,
St. Clair, St. Joseph, Schoolcraft, Van Buren, Washtenaw, and Wayne.

Effective April 1, 2017, Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) local
offices will no longer authorize NEMT for any MI Choice participants. Each local office should
designate a staff person to work with MI Choice waiver agencies to identify MI Choice
participants who currently receive NEMT services through MDHHS. That staff person will be
responsible for assisting with transferring the authorization of NEMT to the waiver agency. A
listing of MI Choice waiver agencies is available in the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM),
Section 106 or on the MDHHS website at: www.michigan.gov/mdhhs >> Assistance Programs
>> Health Care Coverage >> Services for Seniors >> MI Choice Waiver Program.

Phase I began on October 1, 2016 and included the following counties: Antrim, Bay, Benzie,
Charlevoix, Clare, Clinton, Eaton, Emmet, Genesee, Gladwin, Grand Traverse, Gratiot,
Hillsdale, Huron, Ingham, Isabella, Jackson, Kalkaska, Lapeer, Leelanau, Lenawee, Manistee,
Midland, Missaukee, Saginaw, Sanilac, Shiawassee, Tuscola, and Wexford.
