Dear MDSS Administrators,

We will be upgrading the MDSS Tuesday, June 29th. As a result, the MDSS will be unavailable from 5 PM to 10 PM on that evening.

This release is mostly cleaning up some existing issues in the system with one new feature for System Administrators. Here is the list of items for the release:

- Completeness Report - Access this report under System Admin then Completeness report in the left navigation bar. This was designed for the STD program but can be used for any disease to see completeness of Sex, Age, Race and Ethnicity. The STD specific variables will all appear as 0% complete for non STDs.
- STD Fixes: IR Report fix and FR fix for a merge patient bug
- MDSS Help Files are now working again
- Fixed issue with Update Date not displaying on all Disease Specific Case Report Forms
- Fixed issue with ELR stamp being lost on cases sent back for deduplication
- Fixed issue with labs on same person creating two patients in MDSS. By fixing this issue we created a bit of a unique situation that could be encountered during dedup that is explained on the attached document.

In preparation for the upgrade we are asking that all local health department administrators clear the cases from their pending work queue prior to 5 PM on the Monday the 28th.
