Subject: Removal of Program Specialists from the Random Moment Time Study (RMTS)

Effective: As Indicated

Programs Affected: Medicaid School Based Services

Beginning with the July-September 2012 quarter, School Based Services program specialists will be removed from the Administrative Outreach Program staff pool list for the Random Moment Time Study (RMTS). Intermediate School Districts (ISDs), including the Michigan School for the Deaf and Blind and the Detroit Public Schools, should not include program specialists in the staff pool lists provided to the RMTS Contractor. The RMTS Contractor conducts statewide time studies each quarter for all ISDs and produces a detailed report of the results. Staff pool lists are reviewed and returned to the RMTS Contractor as described in the School Based Services RMTS Chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual.
