Access to oral health care for
people living with HIV/AIDS

About the program

The Michigan Dental Program (MDP) is a comprehensive federally funded dental access program for people living with HIV/AIDS, funded under the Ryan White CARE Act.

The program is a partnership between the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and Delta Dental of Michigan.

Eligibility

People living with HIV/AIDS qualify for the MDP if you:

- Live in Michigan.
- Have applied for public assistance such as Medicaid or the Healthy Michigan Plan within the last 90 days.
- Have a gross income of less than 500 percent of the federal poverty level. In 2017 for a one-person household, this is an annual income of less than \$60,300. This number increases in households with more people.
- Do not already have private dental insurance.

How to apply

A Michigan Dental Program application form is available on the MDP website accessible through michigan.gov/oralhealth. Case management and client advocacy agencies can assist applicants if needed.

If you are accepted into the program, you will receive an acceptance letter from MDP. A personal identification number will be provided to you on your Delta Dental ID card.

Services offered through the Michigan Dental Program

- Exams
- X-rays
- Cleanings
- Fluoride treatments and sealants
- Fillings and crowns
- Root canals
- Removal of teeth
- Dentures

The program has specific guidelines about the services provided, and limitations may apply. You will not have to pay for services that MDP covers when you visit a participating dentist. Applicants should contact the MDP for complete information about covered services.

Find a participating dentist

MDP members are covered under a Delta Dental PPOSM plan, which means that you must seek care from dentists participating in the Delta Dental PPO network in order to receive benefits.
