Subject: Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) reimbursement rates

Effective: August 1, 2012

Programs Affected: Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

Effective for dates of service on or after August 1, 2012, the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) is revising reimbursement rates for NEMT personal and volunteer drivers. Following the effective date, all personal vehicles providing NEMT services will be reimbursed 23.0 cents per mile. Registered volunteer service drivers and foster care parents will be reimbursed 55.5 cents per mile.
