Fish from the Kalamazoo River Before & After the Oil Spill

The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) tested filets from fish caught in the oil spill area.

The chemicals tested included those found in the spilled oil, as well as those that are often found in Michigan fish. Guidelines for choosing fish from the Kalamazoo River are available in the **MDCH Eat Safe Fish Guide**.

MDCH will be testing more fish in the future to check for any changes. The **Eat Safe Fish Guide** will be updated as needed if chemical levels change.
