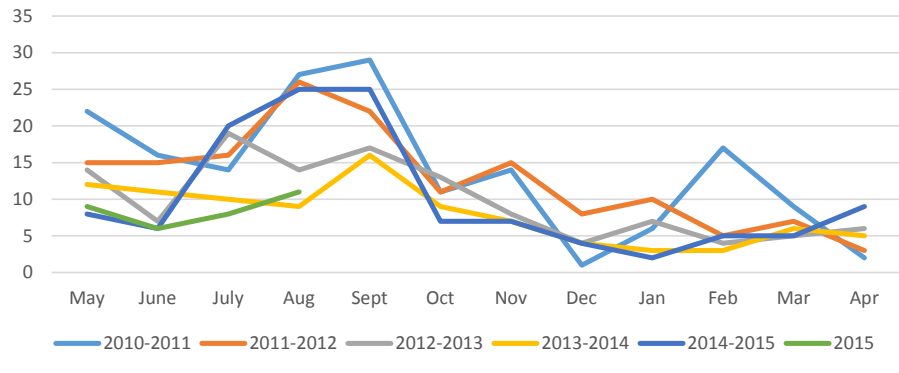
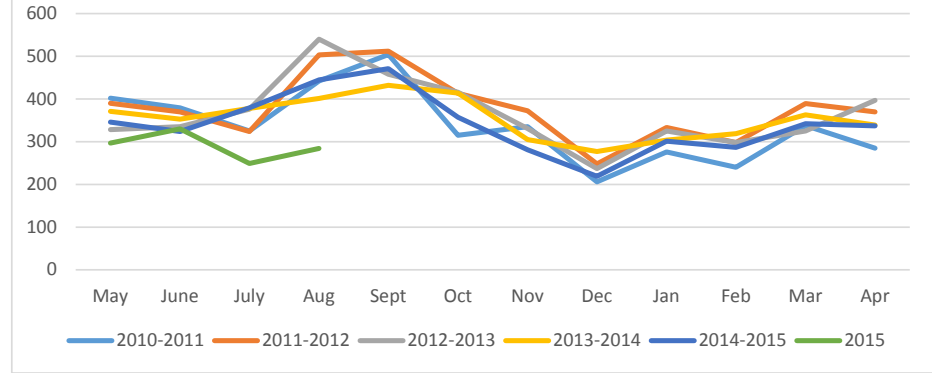


City of Flint, Children less than 16 years of age with First-Time Elevated Blood Lead Levels*
