### List of Required MI Health Link Services

Each MI Health Link health plan must offer covered Medicare and Medicaid services. All services are provided based on medical need, and some services are provided by regional prepaid inpatient health plans (PIHPs). MI Health Link health plans can offer additional plan covered services. Many services require enrollees to meet specific criteria/requirements. Check with your health plan regarding requirements and prior authorizations.

Enrollees must choose the waiver program that can best meet their needs, and they can be enrolled in the waiver at the same time as they are enrolled in MI Health Link if their application is approved.
