

MI HEARTSafe School Program Progress Report

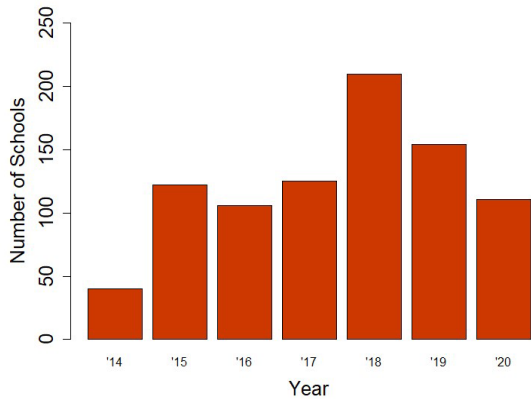


The MI HEARTSafe School program is dedicated to ensuring schools' preparedness in the event of a sudden cardiac emergency. This document summarizes the progress of the program as of 2020.



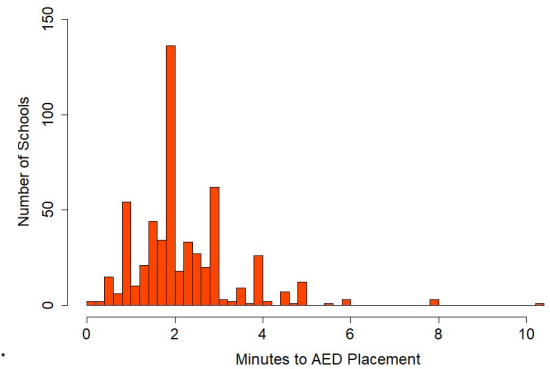
Progress & Success

MI HEARTSafe School Awards per year



- ❖ An average of 124 schools are awarded with the MI HEARTSafe designation each year.
- ❖ School's preparedness as reported by sudden cardiac emergency events indicates program success.
- ❖ Program information has reached 54 counties (64%).
- ❖ Cardiac emergency drill time in schools averaged two minutes, 13 seconds from 2016 to 2020, and 83% of schools completed their drill in three minutes or less.

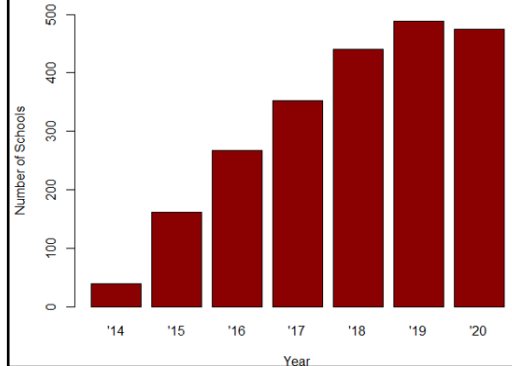
Emergency Cardiac Drill Time to AED placement



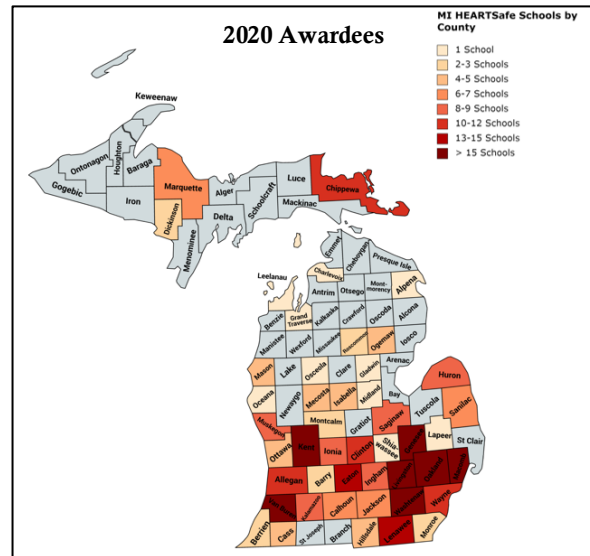
2020 Analysis

- ❖ There are 475 awarded schools across Michigan.
- ❖ Average percentage of students in HEARTSafe schools receiving CPR/Automated External Defibrillator (AED) instruction is 25%.
- ❖ More than half (54%) of HEARTSafe schools indicate that they utilize community resources to assist with cardiac emergency drills or CPR and AED instruction.

HEARTSafe Current Awarded Schools per Year

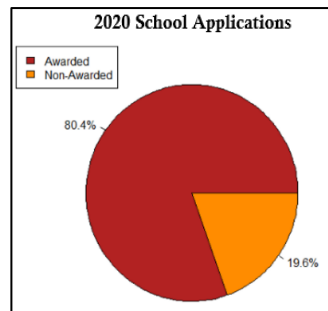

Moving Forward

- ❖ Each year, schools apply for MI HEARTSafe but are not awarded because they do not complete the application for the following reasons:
 - 1.) School does not have enough AEDs.
 - 2.) School is unable to complete a cardiac emergency drill.
 - 3.) School does not have a written cardiac emergency response plan.
- ❖ Michigan Alliance for Prevention of Sudden Cardiac Death of the Young (MAP-SCDY) will continue the drill raffle challenge annually to engage and financially support schools with AEDs, while ensuring completion of annual cardiac emergency drills.
- ❖ MAP-SCDY will continue to assess application data alongside new survey data, such as the Michigan High School Athletic Association analysis, to ensure positive program directions.
