- You have Medicaid, Healthy Michigan Plan or MIChild
- You have a qualifying health condition

You must have been diagnosed with:

- Depression and/or
- Anxiety

Plus one or more of the following conditions to qualfy:

- Diabetes
- Heart Disease
- Hypertension
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Asthma
