

Alternate Pathway for Non-Board Certified Surgeons and Physicians

Non-Board certified surgeons and physicians that have not received their training in the US or Canada must be able to document the following to be included on the trauma panel:

- Training program is consistent with the length of training in the US
- Current in Advanced Trauma Life Support training
- 48 hours in trauma related CME within the past three years
- Present for at least 50% of the trauma education and performance improvement meetings
- Participate in local, regional (Michigan Criteria) or national meetings
- Provide a list of patients treated for injury in the last year with corresponding injury severity score and outcome data
- Morbidity and mortality results compared against other members of the call panel (report card)
- Licensed and approved for full unrestricted privileges by the facilities credentialing committee
- Care given is deemed adequate by the site reviewer
