RE: Submission of Renewal Applications for Children's Waiver Program, Habilitation Supports Waiver, Waiver for Children with Serious Emotional Disturbances

The purpose of this letter is to inform interested parties that the proposed renewal applications for Children's Waiver Program (CWP), Habilitation Supports Waiver (HSW) and Waiver for Children with Serious Emotional Disturbances (SEDW) have been revised to reflect that waiver changes regarding the 298 site implementation initiative will not be submitted to CMS at this time. The revised applications are now available for review and comment. All public comments provided with the original proposed renewal applications will be accepted along with any new comments submitted during the comment period. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) intends to submit the renewal applications by July 25, 2019 to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for approval.

The following changes are included in the proposed renewal applications for CWP, HSW, and SEDW:

- Overnight Health & Safety Supports is added as a new service to the CWP.
- Overnight Health & Safety Supports, Non-Family Training, and Fiscal Intermediary are added as new services to the HSW.
- Overnight Health & Safety Supports and Fiscal Intermediary are added as new services to the SEDW.
- Removal of Transitional Services from the SEDW as the services have not been utilized.
- Increasing the number of beneficiaries that can be served by the CWP.
- Change to a capitated reimbursement model from a Fee-for-Service reimbursement model for the CWP and the SEDW.

The anticipated effective date for the renewal applications is October 1, 2019.
