Inpatient and Outpatient Hospital Short Stay Reimbursement State Plan Amendment Request

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to adjust its Short Hospital Stay rate of reimbursement for certain outpatient and inpatient stays to maintain budget neutrality as described in policy bulletin MSA 15-17. This adjustment is effective for outpatient dates of service or inpatient discharges on and after October 1, 2017. MDHHS will continue to monitor established diagnosis codes and reimbursement to ensure budget neutrality is maintained. Short Hospital Stay rates of reimbursement and applicable diagnosis codes will be published on the MDHHS website at www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders >> Billing and Reimbursement >> Provider Specific Information >> ("Inpatient Hospitals") or "Outpatient Hospitals").
