

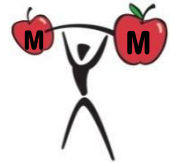
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## Key Points of

MI Health Link is a new Michigan health care program which blends Medicare & Medicaid programs together to eliminate gaps or overlaps in your care. With MI Health Link **you keep your Medicare & Medicaid** benefits and gain the added benefit of Care Coordination.

**Care Coordination** is a primary benefit of MI Health Link. Your care coordinator will get to know you and help you create a personal care plan based on your goals. Your care coordinator will connect you to supports and services you need to be healthy and live where you want.

There **are no deductibles or co-pays** for in-network services, including prescription drugs. Your plan may offer extra benefits, like foot care or hearing aids, for which you do not pay premiums or co-pays.

**Before enrolling**, compare health plan benefits. You can check what medications are covered and see if extra benefits are covered by the MI Health Link health plans. You can also see which providers participate in the plans. To check these types of details, call the Michigan Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program (MMAP) at 1-800-803-7174.



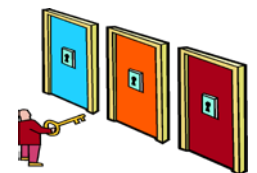
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You can enroll over the phone so there is **no paperwork to fill out!** To **enroll** call Michigan ENROLLS toll-free at **1-800-975-7630**. TTY users may call 1-888-263-5897. Michigan ENROLLS can see the MI Health Link health plans in which your doctors are members. Call Michigan ENROLLS if you decide to change plans or if you decide MI Health Link is not for you.

You can join MI Health Link or change your health plan at any time. **If you do not call Michigan ENROLLS to choose a plan or opt out, a health plan may be chosen for you but you will be notified first by letter.** You can still call to change your health plan or opt-out.
