Medicaid Ambulance Rate Adjustment

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) intends to adjust reimbursement rates for Medicaid covered ambulance services.

In response to Public Act 104 on June 30, 2015, MDHHS is authorized to implement a Quality Assurance Assessment Program (QAAP) to increase Medicaid reimbursement to ambulance providers. The funds generated by the QAAP will be utilized as the state match to draw down additional federal funding to support increased Medicaid reimbursement rates to ambulance providers.

Effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2018, non-air ambulance provider rates will increase by 20%.

This change will result in an estimated gross cost of \$10.3 million to the State of Michigan.
