Subject: Graduate Medical Education (GME) Innovations Agreements

GME Innovations Agreements support innovative GME programs that emphasize the importance of coordinated care, health promotions and psychiatric care in integrated systems. The purpose of this GME training is to develop the skills and experience necessary to provide psychiatric services utilized by Michigan Medicaid patient groups. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) will modify an existing GME Innovations Hospital Program agreement to update the hospital partner from Edward W. Sparrow Hospital to Hurley Medical Center. The agreement with Hurley Medical Center is effective July 1, 2018 and will amount to \$2,018,078 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 and \$4,381,078 in FY 2019 and future years.


