## Mileage Reimbursement Adjustment for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services intends to adjust Medicaid fee-for-service non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) mileage reimbursement rates. Effective December 1, 2019, the following rates will be adjusted:

- The mileage reimbursement rate for beneficiaries providing their own transportation, or an individual with vested interest (e.g., family or friend), will be \$0.58/mile.
- The mileage reimbursement rate for commercial, non-profit, medical facilities, demand response public or paratransit transportation, or local health departments will be \$0.58/mile.
- The mileage reimbursement rate for wheelchair lift or Medi-Van vehicles owned by a commercial, public or paratransit, or nonprofit agency will be \$0.58/mile and \$35/round-trip.

NEMT mileage reimbursement rates will align with mileage rates maintained by the State of Michigan Standardized Travel Regulations issued by the Michigan Civil Service Commission and Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget.

This change will result in an estimated gross cost of \$609,728.17 to the State of Michigan.
