**Objective:** During the 2020 to 2023 application period, the RTN will assess the general medical community concerning preferences for updates related to trauma system information and educational opportunities.

**Progress:** This indicator was discussed at the March RTAC meeting. The committee was tasked with defining what the “general medical community” is. It was suggested to reach out to the Michigan Trauma Coalition as they speak to the general public as well as the medical community. Another suggestion was made to add a standing agenda item to allow updates from trauma program managers. The goal of improving the initial scoring from 1, could be obtained by better defining the indicator.

### Infrastructure

**Objective:** By December 31, 2023, the RTN, with the assistance of the RPSRO, will develop a system to collect data that will allow for the monitoring of interfacility transfers.

**Progress:** This indicator was discussed at both the March RPSRO and RTAC meetings. It was explained how MIEMSS is the repository for EMS PCR run sheets, and Biospatial is the data analysis and display platform that pulls data from the repository. Opportunities have been identified within the data available regarding interfacility transfer of burn patients. A small work group within the RPSRO will evaluate the data and report it out to the RTAC. This indicator has crossover between Infrastructure and the RPSRO inventory.
