

## ImageTrend User Survey Results

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MDHHS Bureau of EMS, Trauma, & Preparedness

#### Data Disclaimer

The Bureau of EMS, Trauma and Preparedness, Trauma Section conducted a survey of all trauma registry users. The collected information will inform our understanding of users' experience and backgrounds, education and training, software experience and role in the trauma program.

The survey was sent out to all email addresses attached to an active user account in ImageTrend. Participation was voluntary and answers were anonymous. Participants were able to skip any question they did not want to answer. Survey responses will be used to inform future education, training and initiatives to support the state trauma registry and data collection.

#### Response Rate

- 115/252 = 45.63%
- Open for 3 weeks
- Received up to 5 reminder emails

#### Example reasons for nonresponse:

- "Our registrar completed this for us. Thanks."
- "This survey really only applies to those entering data into ImageTrend. All of us that are higher level centers do not enter into that, we have our own registries. This really only applies to those submitting directly into IT."






















### Are there any known data mapping issues?


- I don't know 72%

    - "Incident Zip code. ImageTrend gives errors for UNK if the incident zip is not known"
    - "I have not used IMAGE Trend for trauma registry yet. I have used it for pulling EMS reports only. This will be my first time using it for Trauma Registry"
    - "Recently I was looking through records I uploaded and I noticed that our mode of arrival
      is not mapped correctly. I can see that the data is in the source file correctly. Pt arrived to
      our facility by private vehicle, ambulance, police... but the Image Trend records are all
      showing the default value. I have not had time to investigate this mapping problem at
      this time."






## Do you collect data other than NTDS/TQIP/MTQIP?
