Dear Colleagues,

This information impacts dual beneficiaries who have both Medicaid Fee-for-Service and Children’s Special Health Care Services and do not live in Wayne, Oakland or Macomb County.

All beneficiaries who have both CSHCS and Medicaid Fee-for-Service and who do not live in Wayne, Oakland, or Macomb counties must have a completed, non-expired DHS-5330 form on file with their local county MDHHS office in order to receive Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) assistance. Medicaid’s Program Policy Division has approved an exception for a CSHCS RN at the Local Health Department to complete and sign the DHS-5330 form when a beneficiary’s PCP is unavailable and unable to complete and sign a DHS-5330 timely. The CSHCS RN completing and signing the form must be knowledgeable about the beneficiary’s medical needs, capable of accurately completing the form, and directly providing CSHCS services to this beneficiary. Once complete, the DHS-5330 must be sent back to the local county DHHS office for filing.

Reminder, per MSA Bulletin 18-20, NEMT authorized through the local MDHHS office can no longer be denied due to not having a DHS-5330 on file before the appointment. Under this bulletin, the DHS-5330 can be completed and returned to the local MDHHS office up to 10 business days after the appointment.
