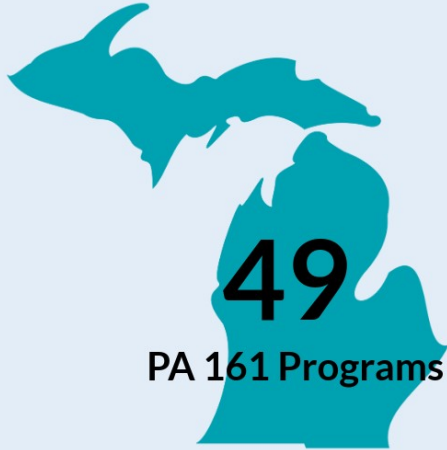


PA 161: Michigan Public Dental Prevention Program



How do PA 161 Programs Help?

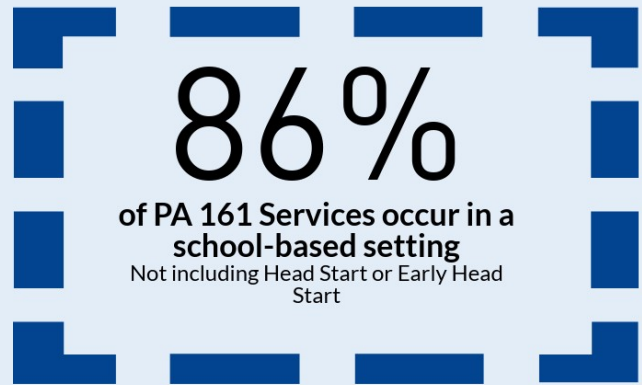
Michigan PA 161 programs reduce oral health disparities for underserved Michigan residents by using a dental hygienist to provide oral health education and preventive services in non-traditional public health settings with remote supervision by a dentist.

159,314 Preventive Dental Services Provided

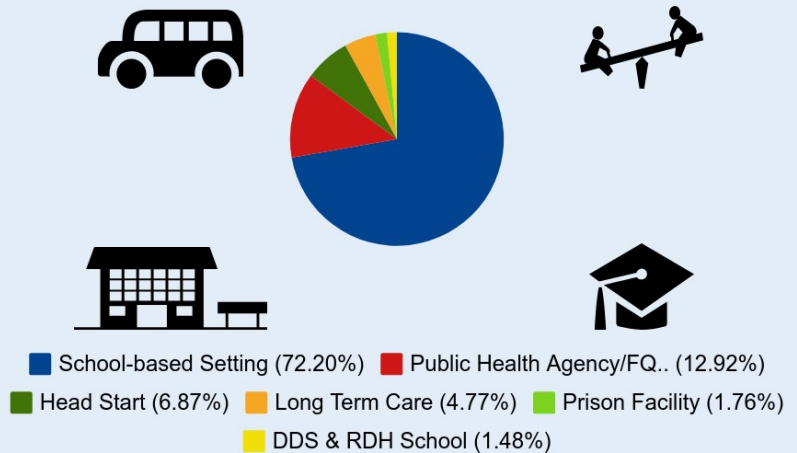
