Injury Prevention

Indicator(s): Indicator 306.2: The RTN is active within the region in the monitoring and evaluation of regional injury prevention activities and programs

Progress: The Region 1 Hospitals were surveyed post COVID response regarding trauma activities. Most hospitals have reported injury prevention and outreach activities have not resumed. Some facilities do not have staff back in those positions, or their hospital is restricting public interaction. This will be an item for discussion at our upcoming RTAC meeting.

Communications

Indicator(s): Indicator 302.10: There are established procedures for EMS and trauma system communications for major EMS events or multiple jurisdiction incidents that are effectively coordinated with the overall regional response plans.

Progress: The Region 1 HCC has been diligent in updating the hospitals with communications from the local, regional, state, and federal levels regarding the COVID response activities, care guidelines and executive orders related to healthcare.

Infrastructure

Indicator(s): Indicator 208.2: The incident management and trauma systems have formal established linkages for system integration and operational management

Progress: The RTC developed a reporting template to collect daily EMResource data for use by the D1 HCC. This report allows the HCC staff to produce reports and graphs looking at trends regarding patient numbers, bed availability and vent use.

Regional Performance Improvement

Indicator(s): Indicator 206.1: The RTN uses data reports to evaluate and improve system performance

Progress: The RTC completed the first regional inventory which will be utilized for regional performance improvement initiatives. The RPSRO will discuss at our upcoming meeting

Continuum of Care

Indicator(s): Indicator 308.1: The regional workplan addresses the integration and participation of rehabilitation services within the continuum of care for trauma patients.

Progress: There has been no forward movement on this indicator.

Trauma Education

Indicator(s): Indicator 310.10: As new protocols and treatment approaches are instituted within the regional trauma system; structured processes are in place to inform or educate all personnel of those changes in a timely manner.

Progress: During the COVID-19 response the RTC forwarded information to trauma and EMS partners the most up to date information on the virus, EMS protocols, patient management, state and regional activities and any information regarding telehealth and CMS information regarding its use.

Other relevant activities information:

During the COVID response the RTC worked closely with the regional HCC on preparedness needs. Primarily the needs revolved around data collection and monitoring. In regard to our critical care transfer times and lack of available services, Medstar has placed vehicles in our region. Any changes or improvements seen by the hospitals is a point of discussion for our upcoming RTAC meeting..
