

National COVID-19 Trends

- Countries with the highest case count are U.S. (40,986,279), India (33,264,175), and Brazil (20,999,779).
- Nearly all U.S. jurisdictions have high community transmission.
- CDC continues to recommend masking when indoor public spaces, regardless of vaccination status.


Level of COVID-19 Community Transmission

Michigan remains in high transmission (since August).


Increasing Percent Positivity



Percent positivity (9.7%) has increased for 2.5 months and is up from 9.2% last week.

7-day average for rate of tests is steady.


Increasing Cases Per Million



Case rate (173.1 cases/million) has increased for 2.5 months and is up from 169.2 last week.

99% of positive tests available for sequencing in Michigan were Delta variant in the last 4 weeks

Increasing Hospitalization




Percent of inpatient beds occupied by individuals with COVID (6.8%) has increasing for 8 weeks and up from 5.8% last week. Deaths also continue to increase.

Hospital capacity is strained.

County COVID-19 Trends


Continued increase in number of counties with **high** transmission.




Vaccine Progress Statewide

COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage






Moderate

- The vaccines are safe, and our best opportunity to end the pandemic.
- Severe side effects from the vaccines are extremely rare.
- People who remain unvaccinated make up a larger portion of people who have cases (98%), are hospitalized (95%), and who have died (95%).
- For people previously infected, vaccination provides additional protection to prevent reinfection.




