Good Morning Immunization Partners,
Please review the following order update and information for Thanksgiving Holiday Shipping.

PFIZER 5-11

The new Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine for **Ages 5 Through 11 Years is NOW AVAILABLE** to order via MCIR E-Ordering.

- Please pay attention to product descriptions to differentiate from the adult/adolescent product. The Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine for Ages 5 Through 11 years has an **NDC of 59267-1055-04, a dosage of 10mcg and is displayed as follows:**

59267-1055-04	COVID-19 PFR-BTN 100 CTN (Pfizer)		
	SARS-COV-2 (COVID-19) vaccine, mRNA, LNP-S, CTN	100	Add to Order
	PF, 10 mcg/0.2 mL dose, tris-sucrose		

- The minimum order quantity is 100 doses (and orders greater than 100 doses must be in increments of 100).
- Be sure order/inventory planning includes doses needed to support **2nd dose administration** (3 weeks after the 1st dose).
 - Some 2nd doses may be due near the Thanksgiving Holiday; Take this into consideration for planning needs and review Thanksgiving Holiday Shipping cadence below.
- Prior to placing orders, staff must understand the receipt and storage of this vaccine. CDC now has a [Storage & Handling Summary](#) available, and detailed guidance is also included in the [EUA for Healthcare Professionals](#).
