

RE: Enrollment of Dental Therapists

This letter, in compliance with Section 1902(a)(73) and Section 2107(e)(1)(C) of the Social Security Act, serves as notice to all Tribal Chairs and Health Directors of the intent by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) and Alternative Benefit Plan (ABP) amendment request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

The purpose of these amendments is to update the Medicaid State Plan and ABP to permit licensed dental therapists to become enrolled with Michigan Medicaid and be reimbursed for their services. MDHHS expects this change to have a positive impact on Native American beneficiaries by increasing access to dental services. The anticipated effective date of the SPA and ABP amendment is October 1, 2021.

There is no public hearing scheduled for the SPA and ABP amendment. Input regarding this request is highly encouraged, and comments regarding this notice of intent may be submitted to Lorna Elliott-Egan, MDHHS liaison to the Michigan tribes. Lorna can be reached at 517-512-4146, or via email at Elliott-EganL@michigan.gov. **Please provide all input by June 1, 2021.**

In addition, MDHHS is offering to set up group or individual consultation meetings to discuss the SPA and ABP amendment, according to the tribes' preference. Consultation meetings allow tribes the opportunity to address any concerns and voice any suggestions, revisions, or objections to be relayed to the author of the proposal. MDHHS appreciates the continued opportunity to work collaboratively with you to care for the residents of our state.

Program Enrollment of Dental Therapists State Plan Amendment Request

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to allow for the enrollment and coverage of services of a dental therapist.

The anticipated effective date for the program enrollment of dental therapist SPA is October 1, 2021.

Effective for dates of service on and after October 1, 2021, the program will reimburse for medically necessary dental services provided by a dental therapist granted a license by the Michigan Board of Dentistry. Covered services are limited to those allowed under the dental therapists' scope of practice as defined in State law. The services must be the type that are not restricted to dentists or otherwise excluded by Medicaid program policy or by federal and State statutes and they are performed in health settings as defined in the Public Act.

The State Plan Amendment is estimated to be budget neutral.
