Good Afternoon Immunization Partners,

Please review the following COVID-19 vaccine order updates and reminders.

## **MODERNA**

- **Ordering: Moderna 10 is NOW AVAILABLE** and is the only Moderna product available.
  - All Moderna 10 orders will include 2 ancillary kits to support administration of booster doses.
  - **Moderna 14 is NO LONGER available.** Some orders were in the E-order queue but cannot be processed because the product is not available. **The following orders had to be canceled because of this. If your order was canceled, please place a new order for Moderna 10.** We apologize for any inconvenience.

## **PFIZER**

### **PEDIATRIC PFIZER FOR AGES 5 THROUGH 11 YEARS (ORANGE CAP)**

- **Ordering:** This product remains available for order. As a reminder, the minimum order quantity is 100 doses. Please pay attention to product descriptions to differentiate from the adult/adolescent product. The Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine for Ages 5 Through 11 years has **an NDC of 59267-1055-04 and dosage of 10mcg/0.2mL.**
  - Vaccine may also be available in smaller quantities from your local health department.
  - Be sure order/inventory planning includes doses needed to support **2<sup>nd</sup> dose administration** (3 weeks after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose).
    - Some 2<sup>nd</sup> doses may be due near the Thanksgiving Holiday; Take this into consideration for planning needs and review Holiday Shipping cadence below.

- Prior to placing orders, staff must understand the receipt and storage of this vaccine. CDC now has a [Storage & Handling Summary](#) available, and detailed guidance is also included in the [EUA for Healthcare Professionals](#). ## ADULT/ADOLESCENT PFIZER FOR AGES 12 YEARS AND OLDER (PURPLE CAP)

- **Ordering:** This product is available for ordering. However, with thousands of doses in the field, we want to stress the importance of rotating stock to ensure soon-to-expire vaccine is used first as well as obtaining vaccine via redistribution from the local health department when possible, to minimize waste.
  - There is limited availability of the Pfizer 450-packs (In addition to 1170-packs). Prior to ordering Pfizer 450-packs, please take note:
    - These doses are labeled for January expiration.
    - All of these orders come shipped with only pediatric ancillary kits, which include only 1” needles.
    - Sites should proactively acquire a stock of the 1.5” needles to vaccinate residents/patients/staff who require the longer needle length.
    - Refer to the Vaccine Administration: Needle Gauge and Length chart included with ancillary kits for information about when the 1.5” needle length should be used.

## **JANSSEN (JOHNSON & JOHNSON/ “J&J”)**

- **Ordering:** J&J remains available for ordering.

## **HOLIDAY SHIPPING**

- **No vaccine deliveries will occur on Wednesday Nov. 24<sup>th</sup>\* through Sunday Nov. 28<sup>th</sup>.** Deliveries resume Monday, Nov. 29<sup>th</sup>. Please be proactive in your vaccine planning needs.
- **If you need additional vaccine for clinics scheduled around the holiday, submit orders early** – preferably the week of November 15<sup>th</sup>.

- **\*Note:** Delivery on Wednesday 11/24 may be requested if necessary. To do so, the order must be submitted and processed by MDHHS by Thursday 11/18 **AND** you must submit a separate email request to MDHHS. You must also be available to accept delivery on 11/24 from 8am to 5pm.
