The Family Center for Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (Family Center) and Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) are pleased to announce a small grant opportunity for the 2022-2023 fiscal year (10/1/22 – 9/30/23). Each school district is eligible to apply for up to \$10,000 for their program. Please see the attachment for the application and guidelines.

Eligible programs need to demonstrate the ability to meet the following objectives:

- Create safe cultures for children with special health care needs within school communities.
- Provide or enhance the school environment for peer support for youth with special health care needs.
- Increase social and emotional support in schools for children with special health care needs.
- Expand anti-bullying efforts for youth with special health care needs.

The deadline to have the application emailed is Friday, March 18, 2022. Please note this is a fillable PDF application.
