

AUTOMATED CONTRACT METRICS

(FY2015 Appropriation Bill - Public Act 252 of 2014)

November 1, 2014

Section 282: (1) The department shall work with the department of technology, management, and budget to establish an automated annual metric collection, validation, and reporting system for contracts via the state's e-procurement system by September 30 of the current fiscal year. The department shall report the status of this work and a project plan to the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on community health and the house and senate fiscal agencies by November 1 and May 1 of the current fiscal year.

Automated Contract Metric Status Report

The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) has had discussions with the Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB) regarding establishing an automated annual metric collection, validation, and reporting system for contracts via the State's e-Procurement system by September 30 of the current fiscal year.

The e-Procurement project is being discontinued due to the decision to include procurement functionality into the Statewide Integrated Government Management Application (SIGMA project) which will replace the state's current accounting system. As a result, the State will not have an e-Procurement system operational by September 30, 2015 as an automated tool to collect, validate, and report metrics for contracts.

Although an automated tool for collection, validation and reporting is not available at this time, MDCH includes reporting requirements and metrics in the individual contract and grant agreements.
