

RE: Aging Targeted Case Management (TCM) Services State Plan Amendment (SPA)

This letter, in compliance with Section 1902(a)(73) and Section 2107(e)(1)(C) of the Social Security Act, serves as notice to all Tribal Chairs and Health Directors of the intent by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to submit an Aging TCM Services SPA request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

The purpose of the update to the TCM SPA C is to change references of "in-person" to "face-to-face" as face-to-face encompasses both in-person and telehealth. This allows for more flexibility to assist individuals eligible under the State Plan. Expanding face-to-face will allow for greater access to service provision for Native American beneficiaries, tribal health clinics and urban Indian organizations. The Aging TCM SPA is effective May 12, 2023.

There is no public hearing scheduled for this SPA. Input regarding this SPA is highly encouraged, and comments regarding this notice of intent may be submitted to Lorna Elliott-Egan, MDHHS Liaison to the Michigan tribes. Lorna can be reached at 517-512-4146, or via email at Elliott-EganL@michigan.gov. Please provide all input by April 30, 2023.

In addition, MDHHS is offering to set up group or individual consultation meetings to discuss the SPA, according to the tribes' preference. Consultation meetings allow tribes the opportunity to address any concerns and voice any suggestions, revisions, or objections to be relayed to the author of the proposal.
